We had a Hopkins County Detention Center Great Banquet #1 this spring and 40 plus inmates attended. When the prayer "Come Holy Spirit" was uttered, he came. What a powerful weekend.

We are scheduled to do Great Banquet #2 at the Detention Center for the women October 27-30. The team has been formed and will be starting team meetings in a few days.

The Vienna team has also been formed and will soon start their team meeting as well. So we will again have 4 teams going out to be God's hands and feet this fall.

One final word about the prison and jail teams, it appears that the doors at the Green River Correctional Facility (Medium Security) in Central City may be opening up the Great Banquet after all. If so we may be forming a team to serve on a weekend probably around February 2006. What an opportunity!

I have been asked how the funds are holding up since we have added these 2 additional ministries and all I can say is that God continually provides. There have been additional expenses of course, but as of the time of this letter, the contributions have come in just enough to cover the additional weekends. Praise God for his people.

Finally, a couple of things we will be working on for 2006 are updating the Lay Directors Manual and our Agape Manual. My thanks to Peggy Phelen, Gina Kirby and Cindy Sasser for taking this on.

Dale Davis will be adding the pray-in time to the Speaker Prayer Charts so everyone will know what time to arrive and we are looking into possibly using power point during times of music and Candlelight since many of the new praise and worship songs we are using now are not in the book.

Well that's about it for now. I praise God for the opportunity to serve the guests, team and community in the role of Community Lay Director. It was an honor and a privilege to serve God in this capacity.

I treasure the time we spend together in the presence of our Lord and I look forward to working together again to expand his kingdom even further through the Great Banquet.
